The results of a survey of Cerner Corporation employees on what types of retail services and housing options they want near the Cerner office development now under construction adjacent to the former Bannister Mall site will be presented June 14.

Retailers, home builders, developers, Realtors and other business and community leaders are invited to the event which will be from 7:30 to 9 a.m. at Canaan Worship Center, 5333 East Bannister Road, just south of the 290-acre Cerner Trails development. A continental breakfast will be served.

"This survey provides a gold mine of information about exactly what kinds of retail services and what types of housing Cerner employees desire," said Stacey Johnson-Cosby, South Kansas City Alliance (SKCA) president. "It provides a road map for development that eliminates much of the guesswork about what kinds of retail services and types of housing are wanted and therefore likely to be the most successful."

The survey was conducted by the SKCA with the full cooperation of Cerner Corporation, Johnson-Cosby said, in partnership with the South Kansas City Chamber of Commerce, the City of Kansas City, the Economic Development Corporation of Kansas City, the Southtown Council and the Kansas City Regional Association of Realtors.

The Cerner Trails office campus is expected to eventually accommodate about 16,000 company employees. Construction of the first two office towers, projected to house up to 3,500 employees, is scheduled to be completed before the end of the year, with employees moving in to their new offices during January and February of 2017.

The entire project is estimated to cost nearly \$4.5 billion and contain approximately 4.7 million square feet of space, including about 4.3 million square feet for Cerner operations and nearly 400,000 square feet for retail services. Missouri Governor Jay Nixon has labeled it as the largest economic development project in the state's history.

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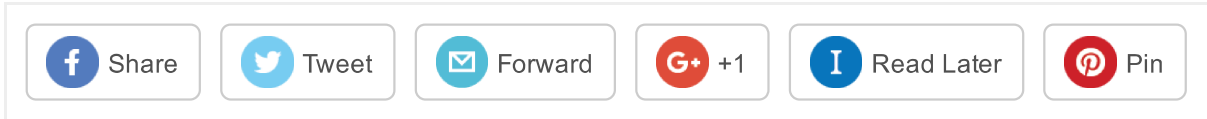
